Dear Stakeholder,

M4 Junctions 14 (Hungerford) to 15 (Swindon) – Resurfacing**What's happening?**

I am writing to advise that Kier Highways, on behalf of Highways England, will be resurfacing sections of the east and westbound carriageways near Baydon and Liddington, to ensure the network remains in a safe and serviceable condition.

Highways England undertakes the majority of resurfacing works on the Strategic Road Network using a lower noise material. This material is thinner than conventional Hot Rolled Asphalt and has qualities which reduces noise levels.

Traffic Management

In order to carry out the work as efficiently and safely the following traffic management restrictions will be in place overnight, between 10pm and 6am:

EASTBOUND RESURFACING

Thursday 18 May to Friday 2 June 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Lane closures only
Monday 3 and Tuesday 4 July 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Full eastbound road closures

WESTBOUND RESURFACING

Thursday 18 to Thursday 25 May 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Lane closures only
Tuesday 30 May to Saturday 3 June 2017	Full westbound road closures
Monday 5 to Friday 9 June 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Full westbound road closures
Monday 12 to 23 June 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Lane closures only
Tuesday 4 and Wednesday 5 July 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Full westbound road closures
Monday 10 to Wednesday 12 July 2017 <i>(Monday to Friday only)</i>	Full westbound road closures


During the full overnight closures of the M4 between junctions 14 and 15, a clearly signed diversion will be in place via the A338, A4 and B4192.


Confirmed dates for the closures will be displayed in advance on signs along the M4.
