We have also reviewed the appointment capacity at Wanborough and have implemented some changes to increase the number of Doctors appointments available on a weekly basis.

It would appear that not everybody is aware we are open on Saturday mornings as there were a couple of comments suggesting opening on a Saturday. Ramsbury Surgery is open from 9am – 11.30am and Wanborough is open from 8.15am – 9.30am for Doctor appointments and to collect medication.

#### Flu Vaccinations - Last call!

If you are eligible for a free flu vaccination, please book an appointment as soon as possible. You are eligible for a free flu vaccination if you fit into any of the below:

Aged 65 or Over

Long Term Medical Conditions, (Diabetics, COPD, Asthma, Heart Failure, Stroke, Chronic

**Neurological Conditions**)

Pregnant women

**Unpaid Carers** 

Learning Disability

Overweight (BMI of 40 or above)

All Children who were aged 2 and 3 on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 are eligible for the flu nasal spray in the GP Surgery. If you wish to take up this offer please book an appointment as soon as possible.

## **Missed Appointments**

We have an increasing number of patients either arriving late for appointments or not turning up at all. You will appreciate that appointments are limited in their number and if you fail to attend your appointment, it essentially means that you have prevented another patient getting to see the Doctor or Nurse. If you are unable to attend your appointment, please contact Reception to cancel.

#### **Keep Antibiotics Working**

Wiltshire Clinical Commissioning Group is supporting the National 'Keep Antibiotics Working Campaign' to highlight the risk associated with taking antibiotics when you don't need them and are encouraging patients to listen to the medical advice from their Doctor.



Taking antibiotics encourages bacteria that lives inside you to become resistant, meaning the antibiotics may not work when you really need them to. This can put you and your family at risk of a more severe or longer illness. We are asking for you to play your part by trusting your Doctor as to when you need to take antibiotics.

## Remember - to order repeat medication early for Christmas.

### **Data Sharing**

Did you know that you are in control of who has access to your health record? We want to help you understand what this means and help you to make a decision about sharing your health record. The Receptionists have a leaflet that clearly explains "Consent to Share" - please ask for one as we need to gain "explicit consent" from every single patient. You can choose from one of the following options:

- ♦ Yes—I consent to sharing my record
- No—I do not consent to record sharing—except in an emergency
- No—I do not consent to record sharing even in an emergency

These three options are explained fully on the leaflet from the Receptionists. Please do ask for one and complete it so we can update your Medical Record.
