CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC CALMING ISLAND AND IMPROVEMENT TO WESTERN GATEWAY, BAYDON

BACKGROUND

Wiltshire Council in implementing its Local Transport Plan (LTP) for 2011-2026 is seeking to develop Integrated Transport measures throughout the County, with a view of improving facilities for pedestrians and cyclists and improving road safety.

This scheme has been developed as part of a request through the Marlborough Community Area Transport Group and is supported by Baydon Parish Council and the locally elected Member.

WHAT ARE THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS?

The scheme will involve the construction of a traffic calming island to the west of Ermin Close and improvement to the Gateway at the western end of Baydon village.

WHEN WILL THE WORKS COMMENCE AND HOW LONG WILL THEY TAKE?

Construction work is programmed to commence on **Monday 19th March** and anticipated to take up to four weeks to complete. During this time, Ermin Street will be temporarily closed to vehicles between 9.30am and 3.30pm Monday to Friday. The Works in the two locations will be constructed separately to enable access to the village via the Aldbourne Road.
